

Frog Mucus (Slime) (sparkle edition)

SUPPLIES

(per 2 people, using ½ bottle glue per person)

- 6 oz bottle Elmer's Classic Glitter Glue
- 2 tbsp warm water
- ¾ cup warm water
- 1 teaspoon Borax

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Pour half of the glue into two separate bowls (ideally large plastic bowls).
- 2. Add 1 tbsp of warm water to each bowl and stir.
- 3. In a separate bowl, mix together ¾ cup warm water and 1 tsp Borax. (If you're just making ½ bottle for 1 person, use ½ cup water and ½ teaspoon Borax.)
- 4. Divide the Borax mixture between the two bowls. (It may help to stir the glue while you are pouring the Borax water into it.)
- 5. Mix the glue and Borax mixture with your hands. Once it comes together in a clump, remove it from the watery mixture and knead it a little more.
- 6. Play! When you're done, store it into a plastic container with lid.

TIPS

If it comes out too sticky, you need to put it back into the Borax water for longer, but if you leave it in the Borax water too long, it will get hard.

You need to knead the slime while it is in the water and when you take it out. It may also help to stir the glue while you are pouring the Borax water into it; that's supposed to help the reaction.
